FOSSR Action Research Session



FOSSR action research sessions, offered among the different types of training to support the research community, is an innovative format where participants are guided to explore the critical issues they experience in their work and to co-generate change paths with FOSSR.

"You cannot understand a situation unless you try to change it" (K. Lewin): action research is a methodology that aims to bring about social change by combining, through collaborative critical reflection, research and action processes. "Research that only produces books is not enough" (K. Lewin)

FOSSR proposes these action-research sessions to co-generate knowledge and raise awareness on - how to enhance social science infrastructures with respect to the needs of researchers and

stakeholders and the critical issues arising in their activities; - how the services and methods offered by FOSSR can be exploited by researchers and stakeholders to generate social impact.

Session description



Based on an innovative methodology developed at CNR-IRCrES by Erica Rizziato, the session brings together participants and the FOSSR team in a co-generative process aimed at producing useful knowledge and strengthening the transformative capacity of services through critical reflection and collaborative dialogue.

The second FOSSR action research session, which will take place in two meetings, one week apart, is aimed at offering a space for collaborative work to FOSSR service developers teams, reseachers, stakeholders and potential users (extended community) for the impact improvement of a selection of **FOSSR services**, identified among the most representative and in an advanced stage of implementation, and presented both in terms of the **process** followed for their construction and their

The FOSSR services in focus will be: IOPP, ORP, VRE, Ontogenia, Poolpo, which will be introduced in detail before and during the session.

Notification of acceptance by May 9, 2025. The action research session is open to everyone, with no specific requirements on previous knowledge or competences. However, due to the intensively participative methodology, the number of participants is limited to 21, and a selection will be made basing on the motivational statements included in the registration form.

The action research session is articulated in two days, one week apart, but it is conceived as a unique experience, with sufficient time between the first and the second meeting to realise some development steps and mature a critical reflection: therefore, the attendance to both days is strongly recommended.

Sessions will be held in presence. The working language will be Italian, while materials, thematic literature and notes on the topics covered will be available to all participants in
