Course description

Longitudinal and panel data are essential for studying and tracking changes at both the individual and societal level, and they are widely applied across various disciplines in the social sciences, including sociology, psychology, economics, and health.

Gathering this type of data presents particular challenges that do not arise in cross-sectional studies.

The course will cover both **methodological aspects and practical issues** related to their implementation and management.

Training objectives

This course is designed to offer both methodological and practical insights on longitudinal and panel surveys, presenting an overview of the elements of survey design, execution, and analysis that are specific to or uniquely characterized by the longitudinal framework, including the presentation of case histories related to three different surveys will be presented which currently are in their filed phase: the Italian Online Probability Panel, the European Social Survey (ESS), the Gender and Generation Survey, the GUIDE survey.

Audience

Students, researchers and practitioners aimed at learning how to enhance their knowlege about the specific challenges and oportunities offered by longitudinal and panel surveys.
